

## Tournament items

Bow (riser and limbs)

case

2 strings (with nock points)

Stringer

finger tab (glove)

spare finger tab(glove)

finger sling

spare finger sling

site

stabilizer

quiver

minimum of 6 arrows. marked 1 though 6 with your initials (ideally 12)

2 pencils with erasers

tools

arrow lube

water

snacks

spare shirt

flat shoes

Have you reviewed the dress code?

Have you reviewed the route to get to the tournament?

Have you lubed your arrows the night before?

If you are staying at a hotel, are your reservations confirmed?

Upon arrival:

1. Go to check in station. You will be given two score cards. Confirm that your name is correct. Note which lane and line you are assigned to.
2. Determine where equipment assembly and storage is.
3. Set up equipment.
4. Go to equipment inspection line. All your equipment should be ready to be viewed. Note you are not likely going to be able to enter the auditorium with your equipment until the previous group of archers has left.
5. Most likely you will be putting up your own target face. It will be clear where they are and when you can get them. You or your target mates will be getting two clipboards for the target. There is double scoring. There may also be electronic scoring.
6. Note that you will enter one door. When you finish you will likely be leaving by another.
7. Your coach will be able to stay with you in the athlete area until just prior to the first scored arrow being shot. After that we will be behind the marked off area. You can come to us.
8. You determine whether you want to be talking with others during the ends or if you would prefer to be alone. Do what is right for you. Some people bring head phones and listen to music between ends.
9. When you are done you will get in line to turn in your score cards
